




OVERVIEW:

Make a basic square using bugles, cylinder and seed beads. Increase corners and sides for larger squares. Make and connect to form 3-D shapes.

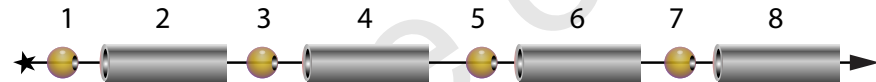
MATERIALS:

- 12  15/0 seed bead - A
- 16  11/0 cylinder bead - B
- 8  #1 bugle bead - C

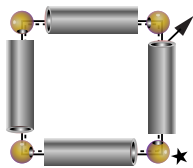
TOOLS AND NOTIONS:

- Braided Wire = 6# Fireline®
- Scissors (for braided wire)
- Beading Needles - Size 12

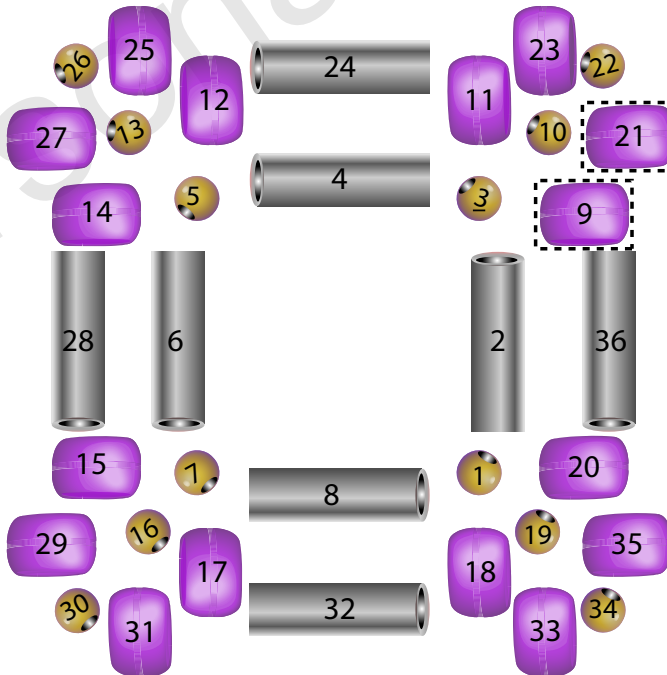
1 Thread 12 inches (30.5cm)
Leave a 6 inch (15.2cm) tail, string as follows:



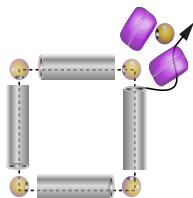
2 Pass thru (A-#1) to form a circle, continue thru all beads again, exiting the (C-#2).



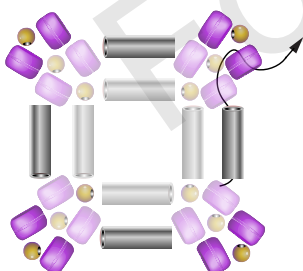
5 Continue corner and side increases, for larger sized squares.
Finish: Weave in threads, cut.



3 Corner Increase



4 Side Increase



Designer Idea:

Zip-stitch 6 squares together to cover a 12mm square bead.
